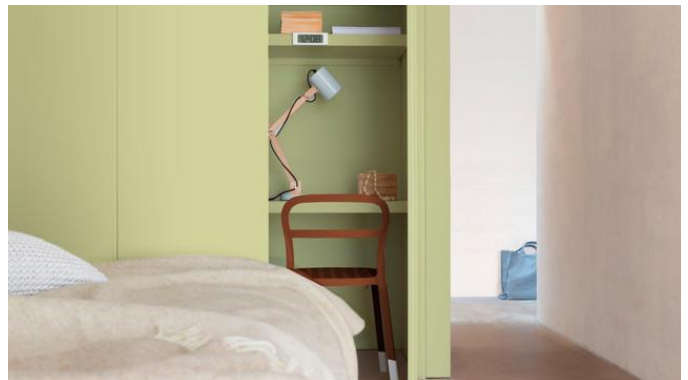

Paint Red or Purple on the feature wall in the East sector of the house/office to bring forth numerous joyous events such as job promotions, greater health, marriage and baby luck in 2016.



Increase wealth luck by painting the colour Blue on the feature wall of the Southeast area; or light Yellow or Brown in the South sector.

Swatches of Blue, Purple and Green are recommended for bedrooms. Avoid excessive use of Red, Pink, Brown or Yellow as these colours represent the elements of fire and earth that can cause sickness or create misunderstanding.
