The 47th Year of 2018 Annual Study Awards Application Rules & Regulations

- 1. Name: The Study Awards of Perak Cycle & Motor Dealers Association Ipoh.
- 2. Objective: To encourage Association Members' children to excel in their studies.
- 3. Qualifications
 - 3.1 Parents of Applicants must be serving the Association's VALID member for a period of not less than 1 year.
 - 3.2 Applicants attending school of any stream in Malaysia, whose conduct must be rated grade B and above with academic results for year 2017 meeting the following requirements, shall be entitled to apply for any <u>ONE</u> of the following specified awards.
 - 3.2.1 Award for Excellent Result in Public Examinations:
 - (a) Obtained at least 4 grade A's in Primary School Assessment Examination (UPSR).
 - (b) Obtained at least 4 grade A's and 2 grade B's in PT3 Examination.
 - (c) Obtained an aggregate not exceeding 16 points for the total of Six (6) best subjects in S.P.M. Examination based on the points as follow:-

A+ = 0	B+ = 3	C+ = 5	D = 7
A = 1	B = 4	C = 6	E = 8
A- = 2			

- (d) Obtained at least 1A and 2B, without any subject failed in S.T.P.M. Examination.
- (e) Obtained at least 1A and 2B, without any subject failed in "A-Level" Examination.
- (f) Obtained at least Grade A in 4 subjects and Grade B in one (1) subject in Chinese Independent School Unified Examination for Junior Middle 3.
- (g) Obtained at least 3A's and 2B's in any subjects, in Chinese Independent School Unified Examination for Senior Middle 3.
- 3.2.2 Award for Excellent Results in School Examination
 - (a) Secondary students obtained Grade A in at least three of the following four subjects:

 Chinese Language, Bahasa Malaysia, English Language and Mathematics and a Grade B in any other subject.
 - (b) Primary students must obtain at least three A's and one B in any subjects but must score a Grade B in Arithmetic.
 - (c) Whole year averages are at least as follows:
 - (i) Primary 80 marks and above
 - (ii) Lower Secondary 75 marks and above (Remove to Form 3 & JM 1 to JM 3)
 - (iii) Upper Secondary 70 marks and above (Form 4 to Upper 6 & SM 1 to SM 3)
- 3.3 Chinese Subject Special Award

Applicants successfully in obtaining B+ & above for Chinese subject in PT3 / SPM or Junior Middle 3 / Senior Middle 3 examinations are entitled to a Special Award of RM200.00.

3.4 Each applicant is allowed to apply only <u>ONE</u> award from 3.2.1 or 3.2.2.

4. Requirements:

- 4.1 Applicant is required to fill up the Association's prescribed Application Form and submit together with a copy of academic result slip of the year 2017 duly certified by the school Headmaster plus a copy of passport size photo.
- 4.2 Incomplete application form will not be considered.
- 5. Closing Date: 12.00pm 18th August 2018.
- 6. Deliberation: In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Association's Study Award Sub-committee shall be final.
